The State of Texas In the District Court
County of Liberty Spring Term 1883.
The State of Texas to the Sheriff of said County
Greeting,

You are hereby commanded to take the body of Joseph White if found in your County and him safely keep, so that you have him before the Honorable the District Court in and for the County aforesaid at the Court House in the town of Liberty on the 10th Monday after the 3rd Monday of March A.D. 1883 to answer the State of Texas, on a charge of Murder (of one Levi Barrow). Herein fail not under the penalty of the law and have you then there this 4th day of December 1884



Witness A.B. Trawell Clerk, and my hand and Seal of office, at the town of Liberty this fourth day of December 1884

Attest A.B. Trawell Clk. D.C., S. C.

This document instructs Sheriff King Bryan to arrest Joseph White for the murder of Levi Oliver Barrow and confine him in the jail at Liberty. These case papers were transferred to the Appeals Court years ago and thereby survived the various fires that destroyed other records at the courthouse in Liberty.

Herein fail not under the penalty of the law and have you thus there this most assured the 4th day of December 1884.


